National Space Day is celebrated on 23<sup>rd</sup> August every year in India - the date commemorates the successful lunar landing of Chandrayaan-3's Vikram lander on 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2023. The 2025 theme was "**Aryabhata to Gaganyaan: Ancient Wisdom to Infinite Possibilities**".
