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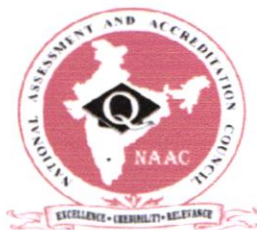

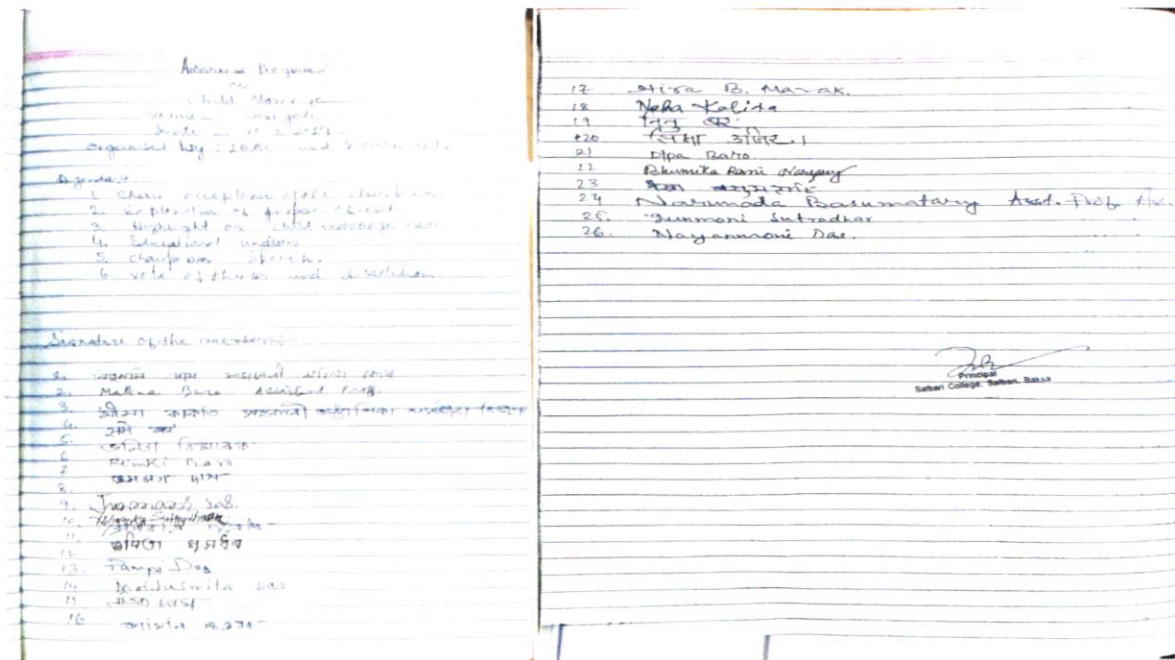
Awareness Program on Child Marriage at Sarugati on 20.03 2019 by Women Cell

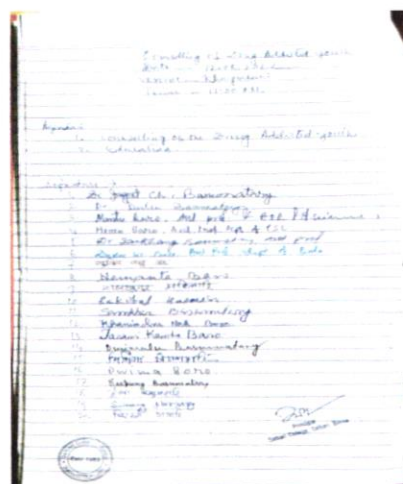
Counselling of the Drug Addicted youth by the college on 12.08.2020 under the guidance of IQAC.

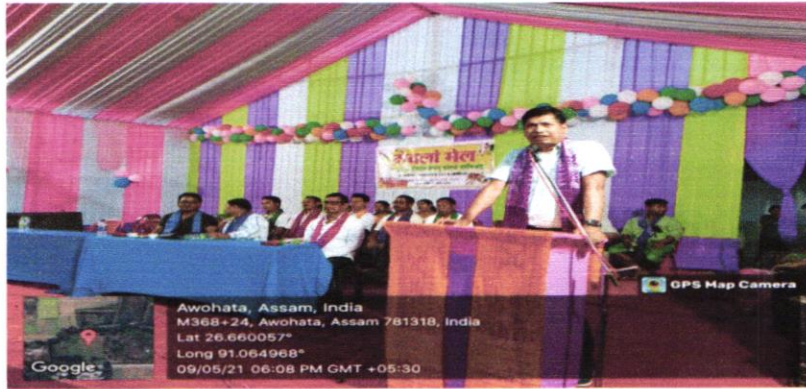

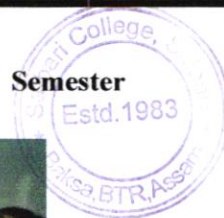

Humanitarian Activity by the students and staff to Swdwmsri Basumatary of BA 1st Semester

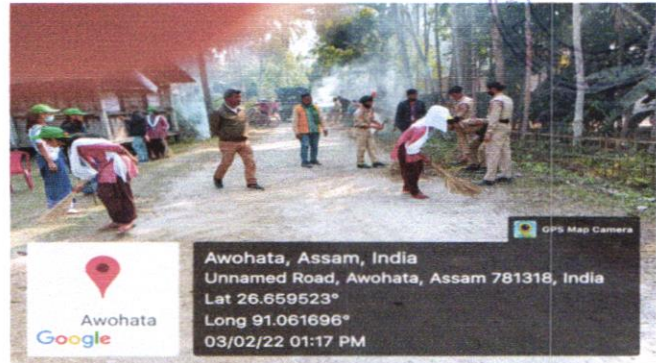
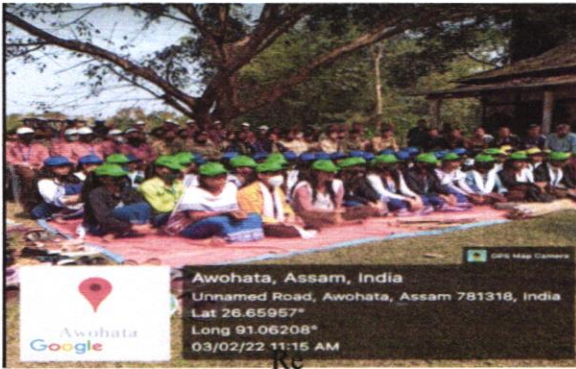

Ninety percent of the household are engaged with the agricultural activities. As such they became economically poor and fail to bear the needed resource for the study.

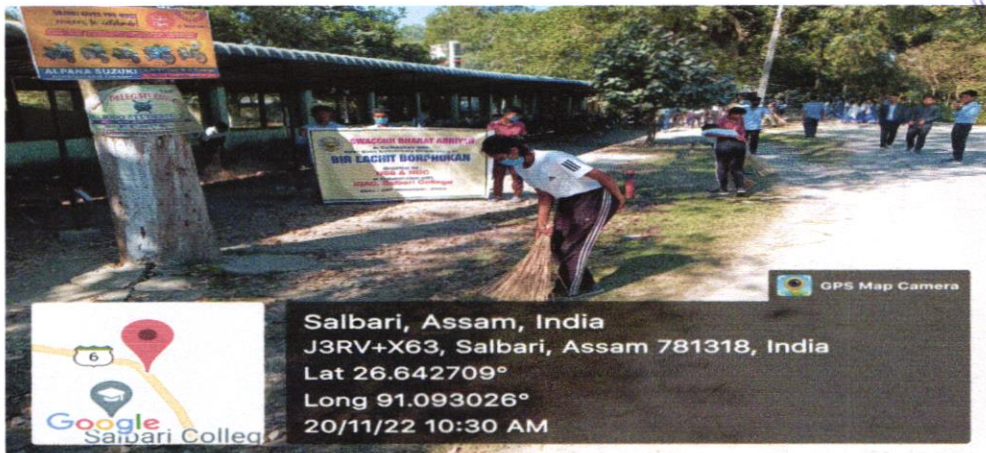

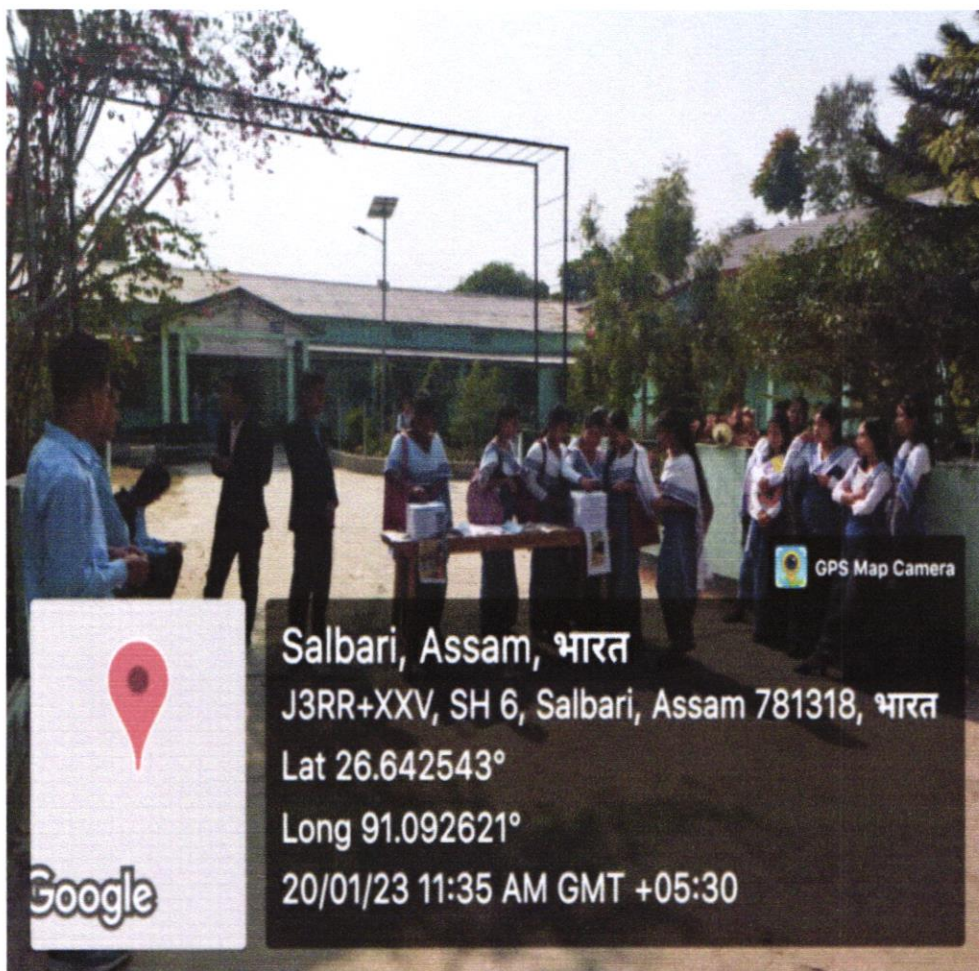

Awareness meeting on health and hygiene at Salbari village on 5/3/2022 by IQAC

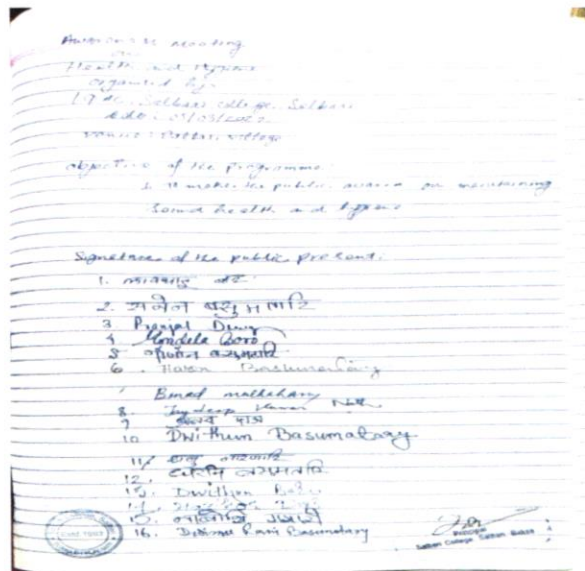
